But if they did not listen, they would know that a prophet had been among them.	<b>Daniel</b>  Daniel prays for understanding and is given a series of visions. The angel Gabriel is sent to interpret them for him.	<b>Revelation 1:11, 19</b>  The glorified Christ tells John to write. "Now write what you see, what is and what is to take place hereafter."
